

SPEECH AND DRAMA

INTRODUCTION:

This workshop will show students what reflective drama is and how actors go about their acting. The students will learn what steps actors take to become a character. The class will define and practice the terminology in performing and producing creative speech & drama. They will have to do several exercises to understand what processes actors have to go through.



This curriculum will stimulate the interest of students to explore the rich and exciting theatre community that exists in Singapore. It is important that students become familiar with their own artistic heritage and surroundings, they will recognize themselves, their environment, their concerns and their feelings expressed in many different ways.

This workshop focuses on Speech Training (Phonetics and intonation, Tongue Twister and rhythm) Drama Skills (Voice Projection, Characterization).

- Be confident and eloquent speakers of the English language, and Have skills in Speech and Drama.
